POLICY ON PUBLIC RELEASE OF STAKEHOLDER SUBMISSIONS

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline a consistent approach to be used by the Canadian Association of Pension Supervisory Authorities (CAPSA) for the public release of submissions made by pension stakeholders in response to consultations conducted by CAPSA.

Background

From time to time, CAPSA conducts consultations on CAPSA's strategic initiatives in which CAPSA requests submissions from pension stakeholders.

CAPSA's general practice has been to publicly release all submissions that it receives during a consultation process. This is usually outlined in the communication from CAPSA on each consultation. However, CAPSA members have in addition decided to adopt and release this standing policy which will apply to all future consultations conducted by CAPSA.

Policy

CAPSA will publicly release all submissions that it receives from pension stakeholders in response to CAPSA's request for submissions on consultations it conducts on its strategic initiatives. The submissions will be posted on the CAPSA website at the end of the consultation period for each consultation.
